
December 2014 Update:

Churches and PATC training school



Our great God continues to bless the work and cause it to be fruitful for His glory. There hasn't been much change in the day to day activities of the school and churches since getting settled early in the year. Bro. Chheng and the rest of the workers still have a wide door for effective ministry (1 Cor. 16:9). This year's class of students has 35 total students with 30 being full-time and 5 part-time. Continue to pray for endurance and vision to preach the Gospel throughout Cambodia, and for many workers to be sent out into the harvest field. Pray for the young church plants to be established on the Rock of our salvation, the Lord Jesus Christ. Thank God for His continued provision for the school. Chheng continues to have a few health problems which come with age but overall is still strong for the work. His wife, Sophorn, is currently visiting the USA for the recent births of two new grandchildren. Pray for safe travels and peace for our Brother and Sister while they are apart.

Translation Work



The work continues on to translate books into Khmer. We are still finishing up the proof reading and editing work for J.C. Ryle's book, *Aspects of Holiness*. There have been major electricity issues in Cambodia for many months now. The normal process has been for Daniel and Bill to work together cross-world via an internet call. Rolling blackouts, which last 4-6 hours at a time, are making translation and computer work very difficult. Additionally, we are in the process of securing rights to translate *Nine Marks of a Healthy Church* by Mark Dever. Please continue to pray for this important translation work. Churches around the country are beginning to know these much-needed resources are available. Chheng has received numerous requests for books in the last few months: 50 copies for a conference, 25 copies for a Bible study, etc. Thank God for His help! This is what we hoped would happen when we began translating over 8 years ago.
