## A Message From Pastor Chheng Nuon

To My Brothers and Sisters,  
Thank you for your continual prayer and support of the Church of Mercy Mission to Cambodia and of me and my family.

The ministry in Cambodia is doing well, and the people are hungry for the Gospel. The Discipleship students are eager and diligent in their studies about Christ and how to spread His message to the Cambodian people. As you know, in addition to studying the Bible, the students also study Computers, Music and English.

The discipleship students have begun teaching English classes of their own to the village children and young adults during the weeknights. They hold classes Monday thru Thursday from 5PM to 7PM, and more than 250 students attend on a daily basis. The students use this opportunity to share the Gospel with the children and to pray for them, as many come from Buddhist families. On Fridays the children will come to use the church property to play games and sports with the discipleship students.

There are many more children who would like to participate in our English classes, but we have no more space or teachers to spare. We are using all the space and supplies available, even teaching classes in the boys dormitory.

Please pray that God will bless the discipleship students and other church members as they minister to

the villagers through the English classes and times of fellowship during games and sports.

The discipleship students also per-

form community service twice a week on Wednesday and Saturday. They perform tasks such as cleaning the local hospital, building shelter for church members, and assisting where ever possible. They use this opportunity to preach the Gospel and witness to those members of the community who do not know Christ. If there are no services they can perform for the community, they use this time to travel around nearby villages to witness and share their testimony.

In May, 7 of the discipleship students will be graduating, some of whom will travel to other provinces to begin the process of new church plantings. Daniel and his fiancé Terri will be traveling to Pusat province after they marry. Borah and Dinah (cousins) will travel to Battambang province.

The church has also been busy,

and steadily growing. In the past 3 months 6 new members have been baptized. Lord willing, within the next month we will have 5 more to be baptized. There are also many new visitors who so an interest in our church. Within the last month we have had 5 new visitors, some of which were also students in the evening English classes.

We hold prayer meetings with the church members twice a week, and are thankful for a steady, and growing attendance to those meetings.

I have been in good health, and regularly participate in volleyball games with the discipleship students as well as the English students. Sophorn has been feeling well following her Thyroidectomy, only occasionally becoming tired and weak, but experiencing no other symptoms. Please keep her in your prayers.

Please continue to pray for the discipleship students, church members and myself as we serve the Lord in Cambodia.
