The economy is doing well and new roads have been built making travel easier within most parts of the country. The Cambodian government is accepting of religious freedom for Christians, and protects believer rights to worship, preach and teach the gospel. We are even allowed to go out and evangelize in public, sharing the good news to any we wish. We thank God that he opened the door so the gospel may be preached all over Cambodia!
